Tuesday 22nd March. Gullane Hill- Gullane Beach and back to church. c1hr

Suitable for off-road buggies. Walking shoes or wellies recommended. Dogs on leads initially.

2pm meet at Gullane Church.

Friday 25th March. Aberlady Estuary and back to Gullane, c2hrs.

Suitable for moderate walkers. **No dogs allowed**

10am meet at car park to Aberlady Bay, near Luffness House. Suggest car-sharing in order to have means of recovering cars afterwards. Pls let me know if you would like to come by Thursday 24th March.

Walk back to Gullane through **Aberlady bird sanctuary**. Binoculars recommended.

Tuesday 29th March. Gosford Grounds, 1-2hrs

Suitable for all-comers, (prams, scooters, children's small bikes). Any dogs have to remain on leads.

2pm meet at Gosford Estate car park opposite Waterston House. If you don't have an annual permit purchase a day's permit for £1 from Gosford Bothy or from the ranger. Walk through Gosford estate grounds. Children need to be under control beside ponds.

Sunday 3rd April. Binning Wood. 1-2hrs 3.5miles

2pm Meet at carpark on Newbyth road on west side of Binning Wood. Gentle walking. Suitable for buggies and dogs.

Tuesday 5th April Musselburgh Lagoons,1-2hrs

Gentle walking. Suitable for buggies, small bikes and scooters. Binoculars recommended. (Bird hides en route)

2pm at Goose Green, near race course at mouth of River Esk. Plenty on-street parking available.

Friday 8th April. Aberlady-Greencraigs-Aberlady 2hrs

Moderate walking terrain. Not suitable for buggies or scooters. Dogs must be well controlled.

2pm on Aberlady Green

Tuesday 12th April. Dunbar to Dunglass (John Muir Way) 10miles.3-4hrs

Moderate walking. Not suitable for buggies or scooters.

10am meet at Dunbar Station. Plan ahead so that we have transport back. Take picnic. Pls let me know if you would like to come by Sunday 10th April.

Saturday 16th April (Easter Saturday). Gullane to North Berwick along the coast. 7miles.2-3hrs

Moderate walking. Not suitable for buggies or scooters.

10am meet on north side of Goose Green. Picnic optional.

Tuesday 19th April. Gullane Church- Saltcoats Woods.1-2hrs

2pm Meet at Gullane Church. Easy walking. Suitable for off-road buggies and dogs.
